Here at St Matthew's we value **all** people, and **all** ages are welcome. Children are part of our family and we want you all to enjoy worshipping with us.

During our Sunday services, we have a crèche area for babies and very young children (under age 3). You are responsible for supervising your little one at all times.

We have groups for children and young people (age 3+) that meet most Sundays during the 11-15am service. We encourage our young people to get involved in our All Age Service, which is held on the last Sunday of the month. If your child would prefer to sit with you during the services, please help yourself to an Activity Pack.

We have lots of different groups and activities throughout the year — not just on a Sunday. We have breakfasts for teenagers, Saturday cinemas, day trips, swim parties, football matches...and if there are things you would like to do, let us know

For Parents/Carers

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES

We want your children to be as safe as they can possibly be — we have a Safeguarding Policy which you can see at any time. Everyone involved in work with children and young people has had a CRB check.



You must supervise your children in the crèche area and must not allow your children to be unattended in the café area. We have activity bags if your child does not want to join a Sunday group, but they must sit with you whilst they complete the activities.

If your children would like to join the Sunday groups, they are very welcome. You must complete a registration form once a year and sign the children in each week (Sunday groups are held in the adjacent Vicarage and children are supervised at all times by Sunday group helpers). Look out for posters which tell you when the children go out and return from their groups. Children will always be returned to you in time for Holy Communion.
